Ten artists first-time buyers should invest in now

For this edition of Design Scout, we toured the recent 2010 Art Toronto fair with **Anya Shor** and **Manny Neubaucher**, otherwise known as the Art Stylists, an art-consulting duo who work with private clients and such Toronto hot spots as **Böhmer** and **Brassaii** to place art into the perfect setting. Shor and Neubaucher are always on the hunt for up-and-coming talent, so we asked them to show us 10 Canadian artists for new collectors to invest in now. The following slide show includes pieces that would complement many design schemes, all priced at \$9,000 or less.

6. Laurent Craste, *Ornement et Crimes 1*, Galerie SAS, Montreal

These savage porcelain sculptures depict heavy tools smashing into vases, urns and teacups, satisfying the need to rebel against Grandma's china. With a Dali-like feel, Craste's striking work will be collected by lovers of non-traditional sculpture with an ironic twist. This piece is priced at \$6,500.
